Diabetic nephropathy occurs in 20-40% of patients with diabetes and is the single leading cause of end stage renal disease (ESRD). An annual serum creatinine is recommended for all adults with diabetes for estimation of the glomerular filtration rate (GFR). This is an E level of evidence recommendation from the ADA (1)*.
