Rotavirus vaccine documentation and coding information for HEDIS compliance

Customers are encouraged to obtain recommended preventive care services, important health screenings, and to wisely use their health care benefits. In support of Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) results, Cigna Healthcare® promotes focused educational programs and equitable access to health care information. Through these programs, we can identify customers at risk for specific health problems and facilitate participation in decision-making to achieve better outcomes and close gaps in care.

- **For rotavirus, it is important for providers to specify whether the two-dose or three-dose schedule was used.**
 - If the schedule used is not specified in the documentation, health plans assume the three-dose schedule was used.
 - This can result in non-compliant records if only two dates of service are noted on the record, affecting HEDIS results.
- **In 2024, there was temporary shortage of the ROTARIX (two-dose) rotavirus vaccine. The shortage had a negative impact on vaccination compliance in quality programs such as HEDIS.**
 - Compliant combinations of the rotavirus vaccine include:
 - ✓ Two doses of the two-dose vaccine, or
 - ✓ One dose of the two-dose vaccine and two doses of the three-dose vaccine, or
 - ✓ Three doses of the three-dose vaccine.
- **Regardless of the combination, documentation must still indicate whether the two-dose or three-dose schedule was used. Please see the Current Procedural Terminology (CPT®) code table below:**

CPT codes accepted by HEDIS for Childhood Immunization Status (CIS-E) rotavirus vaccine

Rotavirus vaccine (two-dose schedule)	90681
Rotavirus vaccine (three-dose schedule)	90680
